The Good Shepherd

The Parable of the Shepherd

1Jesus said, "I am telling you the truth: the man who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in some other way, is a thief and a robber. 2The man who goes in through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. 3The gatekeeper opens the gate for him; the sheep hear his voice as he calls his own sheep by name, and he leads them out. 4When he has brought them out, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they know his voice. 5They will not follow someone else; instead, they will run away from such a person, because they do not know his voice."

6Jesus told them this parable, but they did not understand what he meant.

7So Jesus said again, "I am telling you the truth: I am the gate for the sheep. 8All others who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. 9I am the gate. Those who come in by me will be saved; they will come in and go out and find pasture. 10The thief comes only in order to steal, kill, and destroy. have come in order that you might have life—life in all its fullness.

11 "I am the good shepherd, who is willing to die for the sheep.

The Good Shepherd—Craft


Things you will need

A template of sheep and a face

Paper, (black and white), glue, cotton wool, scissors and googly eyes if available, string and pegs, toilet roll tube to make a 3d sheep.











The Good Shepherd—Print out the sheet or copy



Once the sheep are made , hide or display them in the garden for others to find the sheep, the winner is the one who finds the most. Decorate the sheep with wool or cotton wool, tissue,

shredded paper etc..



Hide or display the sheep in the house or garden (a peg is useful for hanging) and then others can find the sheep, the winner is the one who finds the most.

The Good Shepherd Game



The seeker is the shepherd/ess— they look for the sheep, when the seeker sees the sheep, the shepherd/ess call out their name and they return to the base. Keep social distance and family guideline rules. Children to be supervised for safety.

The people hiding are the sheep (children can wear their masks)



The Good Shepherd—Game

Hide the toy sheep

- 1. Hide the sheep
- 2. Look for the sheep



- As the Seekers get nearer baa loudly as they move away baa quietly (rules like the hot or cold game)
- 4. Have a small box or pen to put the sheep in once found



If the toys above are available, use these as the seekers get close to the hidden sheep to help and encourage them with direction.



The Good Shepherd—Game

Baa baa—little sheep (same rules as squeak piggy squeak game)

You will need a blind fold and chairs or cushions

- 1. One person is blind folded
- 2. Everyone else stands or sits down,
- 3. The blind folded person taps gently the shoulder of one person
- 4. The person then makes the sound, bleat of a sheep, Baa, Baa!!
- 5. The blind folded person guesses who it is. Have fun!! Take turns
