## GO! Sea Life Medley (55190)

GO! Circles-1-1/2", 1-3/4", 2-1/4", 2-1/2" (55155)

## Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" finished) (55014 or 55017)

## Additional Cutting Directions:

## Assorted Colors:

- Use GO! Sea Life Medley (55190). Cut 3-2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for seahorses. Cut 3-3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares for starfish. Cut 6-3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for fish. Cut $2-3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles for crab. Cut 13 eyes. Place some rectangles fabric side up and some fabric side down to have sea life swimming in different directions.
- Use GO! Circles (55155). Cut 2—2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for 5—1-3/4" circles. Cut 2—2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for 8-1-1/2" circles.


## Blue:

- Use GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017) to cut $4 — 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $11 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## Sand

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew one yellow and one light brown 4 " finished square (Shape 1) together as shown. Make two half block units.
2. Sew two half block units together as shown. Make one Sand block.

## Water

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew one blue and one light blue 4 " finished square (Shape 1) together as shown. Make two half block units.
2. Sew two half block units together as shown. Make one Water block.

## Seaweed

NOTE: Directions will be for one $8^{\prime \prime}$ finished block. Make 12 blocks.

1. Sew one blue and one green \#1-2" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) together as shown. Make 1 blue/green \#1, blue/green \#2, light blue/green \#1, light blue/green \#2 HST.
2. Sew one blue/green \#1 HST and one blue 2" finished Square (Shape 2) together as shown. Make one each color combination HST/square as shown.
3. Sew one blue/green \#1 and one blue/green \#2 HST/square combination as shown. Make one blue weed quarter block unit. Repeat with one light blue/green \#1 and one light blue/green \#2 HST/square combination as shown. Make one light blue weed quarter block.


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4. Sew one light blue 4" finished square (Shape 1) to one blue weed quarter block unit as shown. Make one half block top half block unit. Repeat with one blue 4 " finished square (Shape 1) and light blue weed quarter block unit as shown. Make one bottom
 half block unit.
5. Sew one top half block unit to one bottom half block unit as shown. Make one Seaweed block.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in five rows of four blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions
3. Arrange GO! Sea Life Medley (55190) and GO! Circles (55155) as desired. Fuse shapes in place.as desired on quilt top. Secure with machine embroidery or a favorite machine stitch such as small zig-zag or button hole stitch.


## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
