Thank you for adopting one of our cats from Kneading Kitty's Rescue! Having a new pet is an exciting time in you and your family's life. Please give them time to adjust to their new home. Some cats may just come out right away and act like they have lived there forever, while others might hide and take time to adjust.

When introducing your new cat to other pets, we suggest you do it slowly, for a more successful transition. If your current pets have never been around other pets, the adjustment period might take longer. We are here to help if you have any questions or concerns about the pets you adopt from us. If, for any reason you can no longer keep him/her, we will forever take them back. We do our best to ensure that the cats in our care are healthy before being put up for adoption. Sometimes the stress of going into a new home can affect them physically. We suggest you take any new pet that you bring into your home to the vet for a check-up within a couple weeks of bringing them home. **There is a free vet visit coupon in your coupon book from PetSmart.**

Microchip Registry

We microchip all of our cats and have them registered to the rescue. About two weeks after you adopt from Kneading Kitty's Rescue, we will transfer your new pet's microchip registration to you. *If any of the contact details you provided on the adoption paperwork change prior to the registration, be sure to let us know.* We use the Free Pet Chip Registry service. You can create your own account for free and maintain your pet's information once the registration is transferred.
