PeeWee Grass Events and Sheep Riding:

**Arena lunch/water break approx.. 12:00-1:00. PeeWee Grass Events (Stick Horse Barrels, Goat Tail Untying and Rubber Head Roping) will be held during this time. PeeWee Sheep Riding will be the first event in the arena after the lunch/water break.

Gooding Junior Rodeo Rules 2024

This is a great opportunity for contestants to learn and encourage others. Let's help make sure everyone enjoys their experience.

Anyone not complying with the following rules will be disqualified.

1. Western attire will be required for all riding events. Long pants, long sleeve shirts, western hat and boots for all contestants in riding events and team roping partners. Grass events are not required to wear boots.
2. PeeWee Division can have an adult on foot, not on horseback, help them through the pattern. The adult on foot must cross the eye the same time as the horse to be given a time. Youth Division will be given a time if they break the pattern and need to correct it, as long as they eye is not broken. Parents can help the Junior division into the arena but cannot assist during the pattern.
3. PeeWee stick horse barrel racers must keep stick horse between their legs the entire time they run the pattern or they will receive a no time.
4. Contestants may move up a division for any event **only if it is not offered in their age division.**
5. High School Team Roping contestants may enter twice, as long as they switch partners or switch ends with current partner. BOTH runs will count towards All Around Points.
6. Junior High team roping contestants may rope with an adult who is in western attire. Can enter twice. Both runs will count towards the All-Around.
7. High School Boys may enter the tie down roping twice. Both runs will count towards the All-Around.
8. A barrier will be used in roping events.
9. Sheep Riders need to bring their own helmet and rope. They can ride without if they choose.
10. Contestants will be allowed to share horses.
11. Goat changes and arena rakes will be determined by the arena director.
12. Any contestant or family member showing rude or abusive behavior to a judge, member of the Gooding Junior Rodeo staff or arena volunteer will be disqualified.
13. Contestants will be disqualified for mistreatment of rodeo stock or any animal on rodeo grounds.
14. A five second penalty will be assessed to time if a barrel or pole is knocked over.
15. A 10 second penalty will be assessed to time if the rider's hat is not on entering through the gate.
16. Flag race-can go around barrel. Flag must be in the bucket. A No Time will occur if the barrel is knocked over, the flag is dropped or if the flag is used for a whip. There will be a 60 sec time limit.
17. All events will be run with a closed gate.
18. Time limits on events will be as follows:
 - Sheep/Calf Riding: 6 seconds
 - Steer Riding: 8 seconds
 - Rubber Head Roping: 60 seconds or three throws. Parents can help rebuild loop.
 - Goat Tying: 60 Seconds
 - Team Roping: 60 seconds or three loops
 - Breakaway Roping: 45 seconds or two loops
 - Tie Down Roping: 60 sec or 2 loops

IF SOMETHING OCCURS THAT IS NOT ADDRESSED ABOVE, GOODING JUNIOR RODEO STAFF WILL REVERT TO HIGH SCHOOL RODEO RULES.

Gooding Junior Rodeo Rules 2024

All Around Points:

- Points will be given through 10th place in each event. 10 points for 1st place, 9 points for 2nd place, 8 points for 3rd place.....
- If entered in more than one age division, contestant must declare which age division they want to compete for the all-around in. If no age division is declared, all-around points will be counted in contestants age group. Only events within the age division will be counted for the all-around.
- In the event of a tie, all-around award will be duplicated
- PeeWee Girls Events: Stick Horse Barrels, Goat Tail Untying, Rubber Head Roping, Barrel Racing, Sheep Riding, Figure 8
- PeeWee Boys Events: Stick Horse Barrels, Goat Tail Untying, Rubber Head Roping, Barrel Racing, Sheep Riding, Figure 8
- Youth Girls Events: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Breakaway Roping, Goat Tying, Calf Riding
- Youth Boys Events: Flag Race, Figure 8, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Calf Riding
- Jr. High Girls Events: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Team Roping – can enter twice in team roping if switching partners or ends – both runs count in all-around
- Jr. High Boys Events: Flag Race, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Steer Riding, Team Roping – can enter twice in team roping – both runs count in all-around
- High School Girls Events: Barrel Racing, Pole Bending, Goat Tying, Breakaway Roping, Team Roping – can enter twice in team roping if switching partners or ends – both runs count in all-around
- High School Boys Events: Tie Down Roping – can enter twice, Team Roping – can enter twice in team roping if switching partners or ends – both runs count in all-around

2024 Gooding Jr. Jackpot Rodeo - August 10

Must have entry form, signed waiver, and payment for entry to be considered valid. No entries will be accepted without payment. All events will be a jackpot. 75% payback and All Around and Reserve All Around Awards for each division and gender. WESTERN ATTIRE REQUIRED. Please read Gooding Jr. Rodeo Rules, anything not covered will follow NHSRA Rules. Proceeds go to Gooding County Fairgrounds Building Improvements. Events with less than 5 entries will not be held. Entry deadline is July 26. **\$10 late fee for entries after July 26.** ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES IN STOCK EVENTS. NO REFUNDS will be issued. Grass events will not start before 12:00. Arena events start at 9:00 am. Arena lunch/water break during grass events (approx. 12:00-1:00).

## MINORS RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

We the undersigned, hereby request that the below named minor (minor) be granted permission (1) to enter the restricted area, (2) to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events, (3) to compete for money, prizes, recognition or reward, (4) to be covered by participants hospitalization insurance, if applicable, as limited by the master policy (all collectively hereinafter called "permissive entry")

In consideration of "permissive entry" to minor into the restricted area, which is the area from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent concessions, and other appurtenances, we, the undersigned, on behalf of the minor and for ourselves, our personal representatives heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigns, do hereby:

1) RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND CONVANT NOT TO SUE the rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, sponsors, arena operators or owners, and each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all hereinafter collective referred to as "releasees") from any other claims and liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releasees of any other participant which causes the undersigned injury, death, damages or property damage. We, the undersigned, jointly, severely, and in common, convent to hold r eleasees harmless and to indemnify releasees form any claim, judgment, or expenses releasees may incur arising out of the minor's activities or presence in the restricted area.

2) UNDERSTAND that minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in rodeo events contains DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH TO MINOR, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which we each appreciate and voluntarily assume because the minor and we choose to do so. Each of the undersigned has observed events of the type that the minor seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the minor, but nevertheless, WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ACCEPT ALL RISKS connected with the minor's enter into the restricted arena and/or participation in any rodeo events.

3) AGREE that this agree ment shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and FOR A P ERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR THERAFTER or until the minor's association membership expires, whichever shall last occur. All subsequent agreements and release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall be amplifying, but shall in no way limit the previous of this document.

4) Releasor of parents or guardians of the undersigned minor AGREE TO INDEMNIFY the releasees and each of them form any loss, liability, damage or costs they may incur due to the presence or participation of the minor in the de scribed activities whether caused by the neg ligence of the Releasees or otherwise.
