RULES:

- 1. Enter exhibits: Monday, August 16, 9:00 am to 7:00 pm.
- 2. All Exhibits must be homemade, finished within the last 2 years, and be the "original product of the exhibitor."
- 3. Items displayed by clubs or groups must be made by members of the club or group.
- 4. No article that is soiled or canned good that is opened prior to entry will be accepted.
- 5. Each individual is limited to exhibiting ONE ARTICLE PER LOT NUMBER.
- 6. Exhibitors are responsible to fill out entry tags.
- 7. The superintendents reserve the right to reject any entry that does not adhere to the preceding rules.
- 8. Retain claim stubs. They must be presented to pick up exhibits. Exhibits may be picked up after 10:00 pm Saturday, August 21, or Sunday, August 22 from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. After that, they may be picked up in the fair office.

CANNING GUIDELINES

Size of jar used must conform to USDA recommendations for that product. Check for correct headspace and processing time adjustment for altitude. Only standard jars and lids will be accepted for competition. Unsealed exhibits or products showing signs of spoilage will not be judged. Canned products will not be opened to be judged. Please leave clean rings on jars.

- Product Name
- Process Method Used
- Time Processed
- Date Preserved
- Pounds of Pressure Used for pressure canned items only

- Large Bed Quilt designed for use as a bed covering, W 80" or more: L 80" or more.
- Small Bed Quilt designed for use as a bed covering, W 50" or more: L 70" or more.
- Large Wall Quilt designed for decorative purposes, W 60"or more: L 40" or more.
- Small Wall Quilt designed for decorative purposes, W 40" to 60": L 40" or more.
- Group any technique, made by 2 or more people (doesn't include top made by one and quilted by another)


