

Columbus Day is a holiday recognizing the impact of Italian explorer Christopher Columbus, whose voyages in the late 15th and early 16th centuries led to the colonization of the Americas. Columbus Day is celebrated as one of eleven federal holidays in the United States. This means that non-essential government offices are closed, with many schools and businesses also taking a vacation day. Since

the late 19th century, Columbus Day has also recognized Italian American heritage and culture, with the holiday serving as a day of celebration for Italian Americans.

When is Columbus Day 2023?

Columbus Day is always celebrated on the second Monday in October to be close to the anniversary of Christopher Columbus' first arrival in the Americas on October 12, 1492. In 2023, the event will take place on Monday, October 9.

Here's where you can ski in October, according to Conde Nast Traveler:

Killington, VT: In 2022, the resort had its first day of skiing on October 18.

Arapaho Basin, CO: The Black Mountain Express usually opens in late October.

Snowbird, UT: The summit is at 11,000 feet and is usually one of the first Utah resorts to open due to heavy, reliable lake-effect snow.

Zermatt, Switzerland: This resort sits at the foot of Switzerland's highest peaks, offering stunning views of the Alps, and more importantly, fresh powder 365 days a year.
