MEETING MINUTES – THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2023

Club Treasurer, Inge Biehl, summarized the club's finances. She discussed the business of expenses, especially for another dinner dance, to be held possibly at Primavera in Stirling, New Jersey. It would be the club's 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and a minimum of 100 attendees is necessary to reserve this venue. The cost would be \$75.00 per person plus a full bar for \$15.00 per person. The house charges 20% gratuity and tax, for a total of \$120.00 per person. The cost of a band would be covered by the club. The actual date is up for discussion, the club looking eventually at mid May to mid July. More details will have to be finalized to make this special anniversary blowout a success.

Details of the club trip to Kitzbuehel, Austria were discussed. There is still one room available.

The club Christmas Party will be held on Thursday, December 7, 2023 at the Deutscher Club from noon to 4:00PM.

Klaus told everyone that Siegi and Martha sent good wishes to the club.

Klaus again brought up the subject of our aging club and board members, and that it is time for a younger president. Andy Weber said he is willing to help out, along with Andy Zegla and Montia.

Peter motioned to closed the meeting, seconded by Maria.
