



#### First 162 Years . . . .

#### 1854:

Bethlehem was founded. Services were held at Frederick Siebert's harness shop.

#### 1862:

Members moved to present location.

#### 1882:

Construction of a new church building was completed. The stained glass from this building is now in the Lounge.

**1923:** The Parish House opened its doors.

#### 1959:

Dedication of the new sanctuary.

#### 1980:

The Lounge was dedicated and now houses many of our historical pieces,

The *Heritage Hall* includes *Confirmation pictures* of our Classes since 1907, as well as portraits of early church leaders and pastors who have led our congregation. The quilt was handmade and includes the names of many families in BLC's past.
