## **Heart-to-Heart Guidelines**

- 1. The Heart-to-Heart fund is designed to support members of the KW Chico Area Market Center facing an unforeseen emergency or hardship.
- 2. Nomination forms are located in the forms drawer. They need to be turned into the President.
- 3. When a nomination form is received, the President will call the person who submitted the form to get more information. Next, the President will send an e-mail to the following people for voting:
  - a. Lisa Bristow President
  - b. Brewster Beattie Vice President
  - c. Becky Johns
  - d. Shari Dixon
  - e. Heidi Winslow
  - f. Marc Wilson
  - g. MCA Brenda Saeturn (non-voting member)
- 4. Once the e-mail is received, the MCA will provide information regarding the available Heart-to-Heart funds.
- 5. The board has 7 days to respond to a grant request.
- 6. If the grant is APPROVED:
  - a. The President will contact the grantee to let them know they received a grant from the Heart-to-Heart fund at Keller Williams Realty Chico Area. Please ask if the grantee needs the check paid directly to them, or to the business which payment is owed.
  - b. If the payment is being sent directly to the grantee, please confirm the mailing address at which they wish to receive the grant.
  - c. Once the final vote and amount is decided the MCA will cut and distribute the check and send it with the Heart-to-Heart grantee letter.

## 7. If the grant is DENIED:

- a. The President needs to let the person who requested the grant know that their grant has been denied.
- 8. What are the guidelines to receive a grant?

a. \*Associates of KW Chico Area Market Center and their spouse/domestic partner, parents, children and siblings or other members of their household, faced with financial hardship due to unexpected major emergencies, are eligible to apply for KW Heart-to-Heart grants. Grants will be considered regardless of the individual's participation in donating to the fund. Grants are designed to cover actual, not anticipated, expenses.

## 9. How much of the Heart-to-Heart fund can be allotted to one individual?

a. In order to have funds available, no grant shall be greater than 30% of total funds available in the Heart-to-Heart account.

## 10. Please keep in mind:

- a. Grants are confidential unless the recipient wishes to share it with others or offer a testimonial at an office meeting. It's very important that the trustees keep the information private as some of the reasons for a grant are of a highly personal nature.
- b. No repayment of a grant is ever expected however if the recipient's circumstances improve we would gladly accept an additional contribution.
