



## 2018-2019 PLAYER OF THE YEAR REQUIREMENTS

---

2018-2019 Players of the Year will receive: \$150 Scholarship (1 Boy & 1 Girl)

Honorable Mention: \$50 Scholarship (3 Boys & 3 Girls)

1. Participation Point: Earn one (1) point for entering a FJBT tournament.
2. Competition Points: Earn one (1) additional point for each person you beat in each event (based on final standings). During Semi-Finals, earn two (2) additional points for each person you beat in the match play round.
3. Placing Points: Earn twenty (20) additional points for finishing in 1st Place, ten (10) additional points for finishing in 2nd Place, or five (5) additional points for finishing in 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
4. Elite Points: Earn ten (10) additional points for each 300 game rolled during tournament play.
5. Special Points System will be used at various events throughout the year. Additional Special events may be added throughout the year. If event isn't listed or doesn't specify a breakdown, then the traditional point structure will remain. See below for details:
  - a. September 2018 – Double Points
  - b. Events with multiple divisions:
    - i. U15 Division points will count as  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the normal point structure
    - ii. U17 Division points will count as  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the normal point structure
  - c. Trios Event
    - i. Placing Points will count as Double, all other points remain the same
  - d. Year End Event
    - i. Earn (5) points for entering the FJBT Junior Gold Prep Tournament.
    - ii. Earn three (3) additional points for each person you beat in tournament (based on final standings). Earn seven (7) additional points for making the Semi Finals.
    - iii. Earn thirty (30) additional points for 1st Place, twenty (20) additional points for 2nd Place, and ten (10) additional points for 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
6. Deductions: Bowlers will receive zero (0) points for not finishing a tournament by dropping out or being disqualified. At all times, we strive for sportsmanship within the events! Un-sportsmanship like conduct will not be tolerated at any time. Point deductions will be assessed when necessary at tournament director's discretion. If conduct continues tournament directors will proceed with further actions including but not limited to further point deduction, disqualification, and/or suspension from future events.
7. To be crowned FJBT Bowler of the Year you must attend a minimum of four (4) events during the season (September through July). Tournament Staff will determine the Players of the Year based on average points earned per tournament and overall season stats (events attended, cuts made, titles won, and season average).
