Welcome to the New Year (2023). 2022 was a good year for the MOB and I am looking forward to another one, especially Super Swap XXIII. It is scheduled for 24-25 February 2023. Penny has been working with pre-registrations and already has many entrants. This year could be one or our best years, if we have good weather.

During the Christmas Party club meeting, we voted on changing the club meeting venue to Slices Pizza. The date will be the second Wednesday of the month (this month will be 11 January 2023, we will meet at 6:00 PM for dinner and a social hour, with the business meeting beginning at 7:00 PM.) All MOBsters are encouraged to attend the January meeting, we will be discussing Swap Meet Plans.

We will have a January vote for new Club Officers. I have nominees for President, Vice President, and Treasurer. The club will continue to accept more nominees up to the time of the vote. The new officers will assume their offices at the end of the Super Swap on 25 February 2023.

My 1968 Plymouth is officially broken. Ben Donhoff built my engine many years ago and up until now it has had a powerful, bullet proof Mill. But, I became bored with it and decided to install a few upgrades in order to continue to win at the drag strip. I had a long talk with my new engine builder (Ben Donhoff is now

retired) and we decided that aluminum heads and a beefier cam would be the best approach to "Tim the Tool Man Power". We decided that we would make these upgrades in 2 steps. Step 1 would be the heads and other associated parts. Step 2 would be the addition of the beefy cam.

Step 1 was easy enough. We installed the BIG EASY Head kit from INDY, along with the heavy duty aluminum roller rockers and high rise single plane INDY MAX WEDGE intake manifold. UH OH!!! That build is so tall on the engine that the stock RR hood won't shut. So it was off to AAR Fiberglass for a six pack fiberglass hood. ANYHOW!!! It ran great for about 5 miles then stumbled and died. The cam had self-destructed. That stock cam wasn't hard enough to push those heavy duty INDY valve springs.

So now we are busy with Step 2. We completely dissembled the engine, cleaned everything and put it back together with many new parts. It should be running by the time of the January MOB business meeting.

My lesson had been learned. Do lots of homework before turning any wrenches.

I hope to see everyone at the next club business meeting.


