#### Scat Pack Stage #1 Badge

Being a 60's, 70's, & 80's fan of the classics, I really haven't kept up with the newer Mopars UNTIL I eyed a gorgeous Challenger R/T. It had a "jaw dropping" lime green exterior with headlights that had accessory sequential lighting of all colors. In speaking with the owner, he explained a few features, one of which was the #1 Bumble Bee badge. Hence, the following is the story of the badge/s; it's meaning as told by Dodge.

In 2014, upgrades were offered for the 5.7 L Hemi Challenger R/T and Charger R/T. These upgrades were considered Scat Pack Stage Kits - #1, #2, & #3. These upgrades not only enhanced the car's performance, they kept the car's warranty intact. A plus for the owner.

Kit #1 – Offered gains of up to 18 H.P. & 18 lbs. of torque and included Mopar cold air intake, Mopar cat-back exhaust, Stage 1
Performance PCM, Mopar
low restriction oil filter and 2
Scat Pack Kit #1 badges.
Cost \$2,195.

Kit #2 -This stage increased the H.P. up to 30. Worked in conjunction with Kit #1 and featured Mopar performance cam shaft Kit: included camshaft, tiebars, heavyduty push rods & gaskets, Stage 2 performance PCM and 2 Scat Pack Kit #2 badges. Cost \$1,895.

Kit #3 – This increased H.P. up to 58 & 47 lbs. of torque. It worked in conjunction with #1 & #2. Featuring Mopar performance CNC ported cylinder heads, Mopar hiflow header & catalysts, stage 3 performance PCM and Scat Pack Kit #3 badges.

Each stage needed to be ordered sequentially; offering the owner to build his/her car overtime. So next time, beware of the badge/s;they can tell a story.
