Near by, James Auchter (fellow mobster) explained that it belonged to Joe with explanation of his disabilities. Time went by and the announcement of the Trophy presentation would be soon underway. I then told Joe we would have to move so walked him to the location with his folding chair in hand. As we were situated, it wasn't long other car owners had moved in front of us and visability was limited, but I could hear. When it was time for the Best Truck presentation, it was announced that "Joe Naulty" was the winner. Upon hearing this, I told Joe "You WON Joe!" We soon made our way to the "front of the pack" and Joe was moved with emotion; you could see the tears form. What a day! On the way home, he was so excited that he cell phoned Arlene (working) to say what happened. I am not sure how much of the conversation Arlene could have heard as the windows were rolled down and the sound of traffic was horrendous.

"Good Job, Joe!" What a proud Mobster and inspiration for others. We miss you my friend!! I believe you have no disabilities now and can enjoy the cars/trucks you love so much more fully.






