Late Collection Policy

There may be instances where the tardy pickup of children is inevitable due to unforeseen circumstances or parents/guardians experiencing delays. In such cases, it is essential for parents/guardians to notify the relevant teacher or Swim School manager about the delay and collaborate to determine the most appropriate course of action.

Emergency Procedures:

- 1. The teacher/swim school manager should use the emergency contact numbers on record to arrange for a nominated person to collect the child.
- 2. If there is no response from the emergency contacts, the teacher should inquire with the child if there are additional family members with contact numbers.
- 3. In the absence of replies from the above steps and after a 20-minute period with no successful contact, the teacher must inform the Swim School manager. The manager can then seek guidance from the Police, Children's Social Care, or the Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub.
- 4. In emergency situations where the child needs to be transported to a place of safety, it is advisable for two DBS-checked adults from the organization to be involved in the transportation. The child should always be seated in the back seat.
- 5. Leaving a child alone is strictly prohibited unless the child is over 16, and prior agreement with the Swim School has been made for them to travel to and from lessons independently.
- 6. Until the child is collected, to ensure the well-being of all parties involved, two suitable adults, preferably with DBS checks, must stay with the child.

Avoid:

- 1. Asking the child to wait in the vehicle.
- 2. Waiting alone with the child at the Swim School premises.
- 3. Allowing the child to go home with another person without explicit permission.

Repeated Incidents:

In the event of parents consistently failing to collect a child on time, the teacher must promptly report the matter to the Swim School manager and welfare team. They will then engage with the parents/guardians and collaborate with Swim England and the Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH) as needed.
