Membership Meeting

Our meeting was held at the course on Tuesday, December 7th. About 25 members, plus the Board, were in attendance.

The current Board was re-elected for another year, and two new Board members, and positions, were also approved (see Board Update).

Some of the topics at the meeting included:

- Update of club By-Laws
- Pace of Play
 - About 50% of players want to activate the SCGA penalty guidelines for slow play. The Board would prefer not do so, and will continue to monitor playing times. Recent games have shown improvement.
- 2021 Board activities / actions / accomplishments were reviewed.
- For a period of 3 months, we agreed to play one game a month where the player can

select his own tees/length. Our software can handle this choice of tees. We will review any/all changes after 90 days and will determine if we will continue this game choice. Schedule of games will be:

- Week 1 Combo Tees
- Week 2 Tee Choice
- Week 3 Monthly Tournament
- Week 4 Combo Tees
- o If there's a 5th week it will be Combo
- In conjunction with our 90 day 'tee review' we will also decide if the results merit going back to a 2 flight game each week.
 - Both will be decided prior to our April games.
- Someone asked how to see all player's
 Handicap Index. While this is available via
 the GHIN App some are unaware how to do
 so. We will provide training on the process,
 or find a way to send all member's
 Handicap Indexes to everyone.
- There was a brief discussion about the Drop Zone on #12. This area is defined in our Local Rules, which are available for review on our bulletin board or our website.

Tournament of Champions

Our Club Champion, **Roger Morey** & Net Champion, **Don McAuliffe** played in the SCGA Tournament of Champions on December 6th.

Don placed 18th in his flight with a net 79 (+7) at the S @ Rancho Mirage.

Roger played the Classic Course at Indian Wells and posted a net 89 (+17) to place T46 in his flight.

Both players represented Redhawk well and I'm sure enjoyed the experience. Congratulations to both for winning your respective titles at Redhawk.




Open the GHIN App on your phone.

You have a choice at this point.


If you wish to just know someone's handicap index only, the select the golfer lookup option at the bottom center of the screen.



If you wish to know the player's course handicap (e.g., his handicap at the course you are playing), then select the "...More" option in the lower right hand corner.




For the "Golfer Lookup" option, where it says "Enter last name or GHIN #" with a search icon, enter the golfer's last name you are looking to find (e.g., de la Sierra). Note: You must spell the last name correctly or you will not see the golfer's name in the list (e.g., delasierra)




If the search finds any matches, it will be displayed below with the golfers' full name, handicap index and the golf club he belongs to (e.g., Redhawk Golf Club).


Select the golfer and you will see his Handicap Index and his low Handicap Index (HI) for the previous 12 months




If you select the "scores" link, it will show you his last 20 scores posted.




If you wish to get a Player's Handicap Index as well as their Playing Handicap or Course Handicap option, then select the "...More" option in the bottom right hand corner.




Next select the 'Handicap Calculator" option.




Select the golf course to be played (e.g., Redhawk Golf Course) or input the name of the golf course if it does not appear on your list. You will have a blank page if this is the first time using this function.




Select the "Add Golfers" button.




Where it says "Enter last name or GHIN #" with a search icon, enter the golfer's last name you are looking to find (e.g., Schoonmaker). Note: You must spell the last name correctly or you will not see the golfer's name in the list.




Press the + sign next to the desired golfer to add to the handicap calculator function. It will change to a Check Mark and it will show his name below



If you want to see more golfers, then clear the input area and input another name to the search box and select that golfer as you did previously by pressing the + sign to make it a check mark. See the next two images.




Both players names, Schoonmaker and Stoffel appear at the bottom of the screen.




Once you have the golfers desired, then press the "Add Golfers" button to move them to the Handicap Calculator Screen.


Here the two golfers we added now appear on the "Handicap Calculator" screen.



On this screen, you will see the players name, handicap index (HI), course handicap (CH), playing handicap (PH) and Shots Off (used if you are playing a game where the low handicap is the base and all strokes are given from the lowest handicap). You now see Schoonmaker's and Stoffel's Handicap Index and Course Handicap for Redhawk for a given Tee Box (e.g., Blue/White).

With the Handicap Calculator you can select the proper tees you are playing from. You can also adjust the handicap allowance from 100% down to 75% depending on the type of game playing (e.g., stroke play, scramble, best ball, etc.) when needed. See the next two images below.





Now you have the playing handicap (PH) for the players desired. A lot of information with pictures but I hope this helps you understand the GHIN app a little better. If not ask one of your board members.
