- 1. The club shall be known as Causeway and Glens Riding Club.
- 2. The committee will consist of not less than 7 members, plus the Chairperson.
- 3. The judge's decision is final. Rudeness towards judges will not be tolerated. Objections must be lodged within 30 minutes of the event; accompanied with £20. The objection will be dealt with by the committee at their earliest convenience. Should the objection be overruled the £20 will go to club funds.
- 4. The committee has the right to refuse membership.
- 5. The club will not tolerate bad language, cruelty to animals, mischievous conduct etc. Any party concerned will be told to leave.
- 6. All competitors ride at their own risk. The committee and club accept no responsibility for damage or injury to horses, vehicles and personal property.
- 7. British Riding Clubs and BHS STRONGLY recommends that all Horse riders/owners have at least 3rd party insurance. Being mindful of this, the Committee require you to indicate on your membership form that you have 3rd party insurance or that you are going to purchase it once a member.
- 8. Horses/Ponies MUST NOT be left unaccompanied tethered to a trailer/box.
- 9. Members ages will be as of 1st January.
- 10. Horse/Pony age will be as of the 1st January in the current year. Please ask if you are unsure. (NO Horse/Pony under the age of 4 years to be ridden on the showground) Young horses/ponies are welcome, however they must not be over challenged ie too high jumps. The Committee at the event/show have the authority to intervene and members/guest will be asked to leave if they do not comply with committee request.
- 11. All mounted riders must wear fastened hard hats conforming to PAS 015:1998; EN1384:1996 and VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and carry the British Kite Mark together with correct footwear whilst on the field.
- 12. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 13. The committee reserves the right to cancel, amend or withdraw an event at any time.
- 14. Members when requested must produce a valid membership card (or screenshot) to enter each class, otherwise the member will be charged at the non-members rate.
- 15. Any competitor withdrawing (after the start list has been published) or missing from a class **WILL NOT** be refunded their entrance fee other than in extreme circumstance i.e. illness of horse/pony or rider. A voucher may be offered.

- 16. Showjumping competitions will be run under SJI rules (<u>www.sji.ie</u>), dressage under Dressage Ireland rules (<u>www.dressageireland.ie</u>) and showing/working hunter under Irish Pony Society rules (<u>www.ips.ie</u>)
- 17. Photographers will be present to take photos and these may be published on social media or in the local papers. If you do not want your photo to be taken/used in this manner, this is your personal responsibility so please approach the photographer on arrival and make yourself known to them that you do not wish to be photographed.
