Salad w/Dried Cranberries and pepitas

Green Salad

5 ounces (about 5 cups) spring greens salad blend

1 large or 2 small Granny Smith apple(s)

⅓ cup dried cranberries

¼ cup pepitas (green pumpkin seeds) or chopped raw pecans

2 ounces chilled goat cheese, crumbled (about ½ cup)

Apple cider vinaigrette

¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil

1 ½ tablespoons apple cider vinegar

1 ½ teaspoons honey

1 teaspoon Dijon mustard

¼ teaspoon fine sea salt

Freshly ground black pepper, to taste



Fall Spiced Apple Cider Sangria

1 750ml bottle wine similar to Cabernet Sauvignon or a white like Pinot Grigio

2 cups apple cider

½ cup orange juice

3 cinnamon sticks

2 apples, honeycrisp or fuji

1 orange

½ cup brandy



Pumpkin Spice Bread

1 cup white sugar

½ cup brown sugar

2 eggs, slightly beaten

8 oz, solid packed pumpkin

1 ¾ cups all purpose flour

½ teaspoon baking soda

½ teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/4 teaspoon baking powder

¼ teaspoon ground cloves

½ teaspoon ground allspice

¼ cup water

Preheat oven to 350 degrees and grease loaf pan. Mix white sugar, brown sugar and eggs in a small bowl, stir in pumpkin and mix well. Combine flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg, baking powder, cloves, and allspice in a bowl; add alternately with water to the pumpkin mixture, Pour in to prepared pan. Bake until golden brown and when a toothpick inserted comes out clean. Approximately 60 minutes. Cool in the pan for 10min before removing and placing on a wire rack ton finish cooling.

ARC & Compliance

If you are planning to do any construction/changes, not including interior, please be sure to reference the ARC Guidelines or Article VII of the D&C's on the Steeplechase HOA webpage and submit an ARC application prior to beginning. There have been several instances where homeowners have begun and not submitted an application for approval.

As A Reminder...

Section 8.3 Maintenance and Repairs. All structures upon said property shall at all times be maintained in good conditions and repair. No junk vehicles or vehicles not with current registration and safety inspection sticker shall be allowed on the property or any lot within STEEPLECHASE COUNTRY ESTATES. Vehicles must be garaged or be on driveway only. Except as expressly provided otherwise in this Declaration, no trailers, boats, boat trailers, mobile homes, motor homes, trucks or campers shall be permitted to park or be stored overnight on any street within the Property. All complaints for any violations with regard to a homeowner's property MUST be submitted via USPS or an email to the HOA.
