

The Six Trials of Jesus

Resurrection Day 2022 Worksheet

Jewish leadership worked very hard to see Jesus dead. It was Caiaphas, the high priest, who gave counsel to the Jews that it was expedient that one man should die for the people (**John 18:14**). He determined that the “one man” to die would be Jesus.

Document your thoughts on circumstances and legality of each trial Jesus faced on His journey to the cross.

The first trial took place before Annas the former high priest. (**John 18:13, 24**)

The second trial took place before Caiaphas the acting high priest. (**John 18:13-14, Matthew 26:59-68**)

The third trial took place before the Sanhedrin. (**Luke 22:66-71**)

The fourth trial took place before the Roman ruler Pilate. (**Mark 15:1-5**)

The fifth trial took place before Herod Antipas. (**Luke 23:7-12**)

The sixth trial was a return visit to Pilate. (**Matthew 27:15-31**)
