## 8. The Minster Inn \*



24 Marygate, York YO30 7BH  
Edwardian pub from 1903 which retains many original features, although some modernisation has happened over the years it has been fairly sympathetic to its history.

## 7. Ye Olde Starre Inne \*



40 Stonegate, York YO1 8AS  
One of York's oldest pubs dating from 1644. Greatly redesigned over the years but the 1890s decorative leaded glass area is still its main historic feature.

## 3. The Golden Ball \*\*\*



2 Cromwell Road, York YO1 6DU  
Charming traditional Victorian corner pub which still retains it's 1929 interior layout, including a rare tiled bar front.

## 2. The Swan \*\*\*



16 Bishopgate Street, York YO23 1JH  
Victorian corner street pub from 1861 with one of the most well preserved 1930s remodelled interiors in the country.

## 6. Royal Oak \*\*



18 Goodramgate, York YO1 7LG  
The Royal Oak dates from around the 15th Century and was recorded as a pub by 1772. The interior is well preserved in a 1930s Tudor style.

## 4. The Blue Bell \*\*\*



53 Fossgate, York YO1 9TF  
Grade II\* listed authentic 1903 Edwardian wood paneled interior including serving hatches and engraved glass.

## 5. The Black Swan \*\*\*



23 Peasholme Green, York YO1 7PR  
Grade II\* listed pub with a mixture of 15th, 16th & 17th Century architecture. Modern refurbishments have retained many original features.

## 1. The Phoenix Inn \*\*



75 George Street, York YO1 9PT  
A traditional 1830s Victorian built pub which retains its historical character from a late 19th Century refit which has been well conserved over the years.
