



Prince of Peace is a busy and growing parish. Since July 1, 2023, the beginning of our fiscal year, we had 34 new families register at Prince of Peace. In addition to new membership, 31 children were baptized! This is great news!

Last weekend the UNK football team, along with Diane Watley, James McKenzie, Bill Murphy, and other parishioners had a workday on the church grounds. Driving up to the church, we are welcomed by flowering trees. In front of the church, there are many flowering beds. At the present moment, the plants are just beginning but later this spring and summer they will be in blossom. Thank you, one and all, but especially Diane and Jerry Watley, along with other members of the Building and Grounds Committee who good beautify our grounds.

We are finishing up with our Phase II projects. It seems to be a slower pace, but the sub-contractors are in demand now that spring has arrived. Nevertheless, the major work has been accomplished. The parking lot, the laying of the sod, and other areas will soon be completed. We thank RDG and MCL for the keeping the costs down and completing the bulk of the project approximately 6 weeks early! Even though the building project is coming in \$100,000 under budget, the \$3.9 million needed for Phase II has not all been pledged. Please consider making a donation to our wish list to help us reduce the amount we may need to borrow. Thank you to all who have donated. Remember, those who make an additional pledge or donation will receive a commemorative gift.

Our religious formation classes, K-12 concluded with a May crowning Mass last Wednesday. We had an excellent year. We are so appreciative of all the volunteers and parents. Thank you to Amy Lowe and Makayla Irwin for their excellent work in forming our youth in the ways of our Catholic faith! Kearney Public and Kearney Catholic High Schools both have graduation on May 12. On May 5, at the 10:30 a.m. Mass, we are honoring seniors from all schools who attend Prince of Peace. Congratulations on your achievements, and may God bless you on your future goals.

#### **Holy Days of Obligation:**

Holy days of Obligation are feast days on which Catholics are required to attend Mass and to avoid (to the extent that they are able) servile work. The observance of Holy Days of Obligation is part of the <u>Sunday Duty</u>, the first of the <u>Precepts of the Church</u>, and are listed in Canon 1246 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law. Any feast celebrated on a Sunday, such as

Easter, falls under normal Sunday Duty and thus is not included in a list of Holy Days of Obligation.

There are currently 10 <u>Holy Days of Obligation</u> in the Latin Rite of the Catholic Church and five in the Eastern Catholic Churches; in the <u>United States</u>, only six Holy Days of Obligation are observed.

The USCCB (the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops) petitioned the Holy See in 1991 to move three of the universal Holy Days of Obligation—Corpus Christi (the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ), Saint Joseph, Saints Peter and Paul—and to transfer the celebration of Epiphany to the nearest Sunday. Thus, the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) lists the following Holy Days of Obligation in the United States:

January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter, the Solemnity of the Ascension

August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

December 25, the Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ

However, the Ecclesiastical Provinces of Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha, and Philadelphia retained the Ascension of the Lord on the Thursday of the sixth week of Easter.

Ascension of the Lord: May 9<sup>th</sup> is the Ascension of the Lord. It is the day we remember Jesus' ascending into heaven. He asks the disciples to wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit in the upper room. It is this day we begin the novena to the Holy Spirit. This is the first of many novenas. A novena is nine days of prayer a specific intention. You may find examples of a novena to the Holy Spirit near all the entrances of the church.

The Ecclesiastical Province of Omaha, which includes the Archdiocese of Omaha, the Diocese of Lincoln, and the Grand Island Diocese, the feast of Ascension remains on the 40th day after Easter and continues to be a Holy Day of Obligation. Thus we are obligated to attend Mass. The Mass schedule anticipated for the feast of the Ascension is Wednesday May 8<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm and Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 am and 6 pm.



The 6 parishes invited to participate, which run along the river (Hwy 30), accepted the invitation over a year ago and they have been planning for these events ever since. We are grateful for their willingness to say yes to create such a unique spiritual experience for all of us.


