Fasting & Abstinence

Abstinence: The Church binds all Catholics over 14 years of age not to eat meat on Ash Wednesday or on any Friday during Lent.

**Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 are bound to fast
on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.**

Fasting: is defined as two light meals and one regular meal and no food between meals. Liquids are always allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, these requirements do not apply. **One is not to excuse oneself from these penitential practices without sufficient reason.**
