October 10, 2023

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Mr. Cunningham called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. with the following members present: Belinda Clark and Kathy Hunt. Board Members Chad Freeman and Richard Johnson were absent. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present. There were no visitors.

Ms. Clark read the minutes from the September 26, 2023 board meeting. Ms. Hunt made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Ms. Clark. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with 4 Civilian Absentee Ballot Return Envelopes that were returned for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election to be reviewed and approved by the board. After review, Ms. Hunt made a motion to accept the 4 Civilian Absentee Ballots and seconded by Ms. Clark. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Adam Moore ran the tabulation of the 8 total Absentee ballots that were approved for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election. Ms. Clark made a motion to approve the tabulation for the Absentee ballots and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved. The tabulation results tapes were signed by each present board member.

Director Andrew Richards reported the results of One-Stop Early Voting for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election. There were 24 Davidson County residents of the City of High Point that participated in One-Stop Early Voting. Ms. Clark made a motion to approve the tabulation for One-Stop Early Voting for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved. The tabulation results tapes were signed by each present board member.

Deputy Director Adam Moore reported that 36 Civilian Absentee Ballots and 1 Military Absentee Ballot had been sent out to voters for the November 7, 2023 Municipal Elections. At the time of the meeting, none had been returned.

Ms. Clark made a motion to adjourn at 2:22 p.m. and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.
