

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

October 17, 2023

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, October 17, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Mr. Cunningham called the meeting to order at 11:03 a.m. with the following members present: Belinda Clark, Kathy Hunt, Chad Freeman, and Richard Johnson. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present. There were no visitors.

Ms. Clark read the minutes from the October 16, 2023 supplemental board meeting. Mr. Freeman made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards provided the board with the Election Group Balancing report. The report indicates that all aspects of the election are fully balanced including One-Stop Early Voting, Absentee by Mail, Election Day, and Provisional Voting.

Three copies of the Abstract of Votes for Davidson County, North Carolina for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election were provided to the board. Each copy was reviewed by the members. Given the information provided, Ms. Hunt made a motion to accept the Canvass for the October 10, 2023 High Point Primary Election for Davidson County. The motion was seconded by Ms. Clark and was unanimously approved. The three copies were signed by each member and notarized. The signed reports will be sent to the Davidson County Clerk of Court, the North Carolina State Board of Elections, and one copy for filing at the Davidson County Board of Elections office.

Director Andrew Richards presented one Absentee by Mail ballot for the November 7, 2023 Municipal Election with recommendation of approval. After review, Mr. Freeman made a motion to accept the absentee ballot and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Mr. Freeman made a motion to adjourn at 11:12 a.m. and was seconded by Ms. Clark. It was unanimously approved.
