

DAVIDSON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

February 6, 2024

The Davidson County Board of Elections met on Tuesday, February 6, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board of Elections office located at 945 N. Main Street, Suite A, Lexington, North Carolina 27292.

Mr. Cunningham called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Belinda Clark, Kathy Hunt and Richard Johnson. Board Member Chad Freeman was not present. Director Andrew Richards and Deputy Director Adam Moore were present. There were two visitors.

Ms. Clark read the minutes from the January 30, 2024 board meeting. Mr. Johnson made a motion to accept the minutes and seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards presented the board with 14 Civilian Absentee Ballots recommended for approval. After review, Ms. Hunt made a motion to approve the 14 Civilian Absentee ballots as presented and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Deputy Director Adam Moore presented the board with 6 Civilian Absentee Ballots returned with the Photo ID Exception form and are recommended for approval. After review, Ms. Hunt made a motion to approve the 6 Civilian Absentee ballots as presented and seconded by Ms. Clark. It was unanimously approved.

Director Andrew Richards ran the zero tape on the central tabulator and it was reviewed by each present member of the board.

The board began tabulation of the approved ballots for the March 5, 2024 Primary Election thus far. Combining the total approved ballots from the January 30, 2024 meeting and the February 6, 2024 meeting, there were 28 ballots tabulated. Ms. Clark made a motion to accept the current tabulation of 28 ballots and was seconded by Mr. Johnson. It was unanimously approved.

Mr. Johnson made a motion to adjourn at 6:40 p.m. and was seconded by Ms. Hunt. It was unanimously approved.
