Additional Tournament Information: Rules & Regulations

Black Belt Meeting to be held at 9:00 am.

Competitors will only perform katas of their belt level.

Advanced brown belts may compete with junior black belts and do a higher kata

A score is awarded in kumite when a technique is performed according to the following criteria to a scoring area. a) Good form b) Sporting attitude c) Vigorous application d) Awareness' e) Good timing f) Correct distance

Scores are as follow:

Ippon -3 points a) Jodan kicks b) Any techniques delivered to an opponent who is off their feet on the mat. Waza-ari -2 points a) chudan kicks a) chedan kick. Yoku – one point a) Any middle or high punch b) Any middle or high strike
FACE CONTACT —. For adults competitors, non-injurious, light, controlled “touch” contact to the face, head, and neck is allowed (but not to the throat). Where contact is deemed by the referee to be too strong, but does not diminish the competitor’s chances of winning, a warning (CHUKOKU) may be given. A second contact under the same circumstances will be penalized by KEIKOKU. A third offence will be

given HANSOKU CHUI. A further offence will result in disqualification by HANSOKU. Disqualification can occur at any time, depending on the severity of the injury.

FACE CONTACT —JUNIORS COMPETITORS, no contact to the head, face, or neck, (including the face mask) is allowed with hand techniques. Any contact, no matter how light, will be penalized, as in paragraph II above, unless caused by the recipient (MUBOBI). Jodan kicks may make the lightest touch (“skin touch”) and still score. Any more than a skin touch will require a warning or penalty unless caused by the recipient (MUBOBI).

The first person to get the very first point in the match will be the winner when there is a tie.

1. A score is awarded when a technique is performed according to the following criteria to a scoring area: a) Good form— b) Sporting attitude— c) Vigorous application – d) Awareness (ZANSHIN) e) Good timing – f) Correct distance
2. SANBON is awarded for: a) Jodan kicks. Three points b) Any scoring technique delivered on a thrown or fallen opponent.
3. NIHON is awarded for: a) Chudan kicks. 2 points
4. IPPON is awarded for: a) Chudan or Jodan Tsuki. 1 point b) Uchi. 1 point
5. Attacks are limited to the following areas: a) Head, Face, Neck, Face, Abdomen, Chest, Back, Side Contact to the spine is immediate disqualification.
