

BY-LAW MODIFICATION (DRAFT PROPOSAL 2.0): ARTICLE V SECTION 5 Existing By-Law

ARTICLE V NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS: SECTION 5 Offices and Terms: The offices to be decided at the annual elections may be as follows:

Part A- Vice President - Becomes' President and Car Show Chair in successive years.

Part B- Treasurer - One year term

Part C - Secretary- One year term.

Part D - Director's - Three year terms. Two elected each year.

Part E - Sergeant at Arms - One year term.

Change Parts A through E in its entirety to read:

ARTÍCLE V NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS: SECTION 5 Offices and Terms:

Part A – Vice President: Two-year term. Elected Vice President is allowed a maximum two two-year terms. Can run again for Vice President after a minimum one two-year term absence. Election for Vice President must not be in same year of election for President.

Part B - President: Two-Year term. Elected President is allowed a maximum two two-year terms. Can run again for President after a minimum one two-year term absence. Election for President must not be in same year of election for Vice President. **Part C** - Car Show Chairperson: Two-year term. Elected Car Show Chairperson is allowed a maximum two two-year terms. Can run again for Car Show Chairperson after a minimum one two-year term absence. Election for Car Show Chairperson must not be in same year of election for President.

Part D- Treasurer: One year term

- Part E Secretary: One year term.
- Part F Directors: Three year terms. Two elected each year.

Part G - Sergeant at Arms: One year term.

Justification for By-law proposed change: Proposed changes are only for the positions of Vice President, President and Car Show Chairperson (Positions fro Treasurer, Secretary, Directors and Sergeant at Arms will remain unchanged). In recent years, it has been difficult to get members, in good standings as required by the by-laws, to accept nominations for the current three year term (Vice President, President then Car Show Chairperson). With this reluctance, and the talk of what would happen to the club if we don't get members to come forward, this proposed by-law change is one way to gain interest in these positions. The thought here by splitting the three duties as individual positions, hopefully will increase membership interest in the following ways;

1) A two year commitment in lieu of a three year commitment.

2) A member may have the interest, or courage, in only doing one of the three duties.

3) Knowledge gained by doing the duties for the first year can be applied to the secondm year, which should result in better outcomes. The reason for election of Vice President being in the off year for the election of the President is a way to provide continuity between the Vice President and the President. Also, the election of the President being in the off year of the Car Show Chairperson is for the same reason. As a result, the Vice President and Car Show Chairperson will be elected in the same year.

BY-LAW MODIFICATION (DRAFT PROPOSAL 2.0): ARTICLE V SECTION 5

How to implement this change IF approved (for 2025) as proposed:

1) For current year 2024: All officers remain in their current positions.

2) For 2025 (voting fall 2024): Vice President (Paul) moves to President, President (Randy) moves to Car Show Chairperson. Voting is only open for Vice President (two year term).

3) For 2026 (voting fall 2025): President (Paul) moves to Car Show Chairperson. Vice President from 2025 remains for second year term. Voting is only for New President (two year term). New cycle starts

4) For 2027: Complete new cycle starts (year 1): President from 2026 remains for second year term. Voting is for new Vice President (two year term) and new Car Show Chairperson (two year term).

5) For 2028: Complete new cycle starts (year 2): Vice President and Car Show Chairperson from 2027 remains for second year term. Voting is for new President (two year term).

Pantowners Calendar Car or Truck Rules

I The vehicle must be owned by someone who has been a club member in good standing for at least one year.

All pictures of calendar vehicle entries must have the members name and vehicle information on the back of the picture and be given to the club secretary prior to voting at the May general club meeting.

An article must be written about the vehicle to appear in the Siftings on the month the vehicle is featured. The articles need to be submitted to the club secretary on or before the December general club meeting.

I The vehicle must qualify as a collector vehicle under the state of Minnesota rules for collector, pioneer, classic or street rod.

Dembers can enter a different vehicle every 2 years.

I Vehicles that have never been in a previous calendar will be automatically selected with-out vote unless there are more than 12 in a given year. If there are more than 12, a vote will be required for selection.

[] The same vehicle that was previously in a calendar can be entered again after 10 years.

I Vehicles used for the calendar must be able to drive under its own power into the fairgrounds sports arena.

I If you are planning to sell the vehicle or do not wish to display the vehicle in the sports arena during the car show, do not enter it for calendar selection.

Optional: A month may be selected to feature a collector motorcycle, peddle car or bicycle.

] The owner will receive 5 calendars if their vehicle is chosen to be in the calendar
