FINAL ORDER APPROVING PROTECTIVE ORDER AND CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

Presently pending before the Court are the following documents that are proposed for use during the administration of the Perrine DuPont Settlement ("Settlement") by the Claims Administrator:

- (a) A Protective Order which shall protect all confidential information collected from Medical Monitoring Class Members and Property Remediation Class Members during the Administration of the Settlement (Exhibit A); and
- (b) A Confidentiality Agreement, which shall bind all of the individuals who will work on the Settlement to protect the confidential information of Class Members (Exhibit B).

After a careful review of the above documents, and in consideration of the applicable law, the Court ORDERS that the same are hereby APPROVED and shall be used during the administration of the Settlement.

After careful review of the Claims Administrator's proposed Protective Order, the Court approves of its language, form, and effect. Further, the Court shall enter the Protective Order

contemporaneously with this Order, and the same shall be made part of the record of this case.

Next, the Court has reviewed the Confidentiality Agreement, which shall be executed by each individual who may come into contact with Class Members' confidential information during the administration of the Settlement. The Court approves of the language and effect of the Confidentiality Agreement, and hereby ORDERS that the Confidentiality Agreement shall be used during the administration of the Settlement. Further, the Court ORDERS that each individual who will come into contact with confidential information during the administration of the Settlement shall execute a Confidentiality Agreement and return the same to the Claims Administrator, who shall keep each executed Confidentiality Agreement at the Settlement Claims Office.

Lastly, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court directs entry of this Order as a Final Order as to the claims and issues above upon an express determination that there is no just reason for delay and upon an express direction for the entry of judgment.
