

## The Valley of the Pines Open Burn Permit – Lot Owners Copy

This Permit is for open burning of yard debris, from the code of conduct, page R4-R5:

(e) No open fires of any kind, including those for the burning of rubbish and debris, shall be permitted within Valley of the Pines, except within a metal or pottery cooking, barbecuing or braising device or within a masonry fireplace, barbecue or fire pit, provided, however, that special burning or fire permits may be issued by the Valley of the Pines Association or the platter. Fires must be extinguished by wetting or burying upon completion of their use.

The following guidelines must be used:

- Lot owner needs to be present start to finish of the fire
- An armed (turned on) Water hose must be at the fire site
- Lot owner is responsible to keep the fire under control and will be held for any damage to other property and/or cost if the fire department is called.
- If possible avoid burning Friday afternoon Sunday afternoon
- Be courteous to those around you, with regard to smoke
- USE COMMON SENSE
