Pole exercises clinic was on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> November at Flamstead Yard arena, Ashley Green. Instructor was Michaela Burke.


We have eleven members and friends enjoying the challenges of the different exercises.

**November talk** with Guest speaker Scilla Lown "How to improve dressage test riding & gain better marks"

This was an excellent and interesting evening talk with lots of tips and useful ideas on dressage test riding from Scilla who was a list 4 BD judge for many years and has ridden to advanced medium level. Scilla has represented our RC many times at Area dressage competitions.

Wednesday evening 25<sup>th</sup> January will be a talk on bridleways with guest speaker: Laura Frey who is a BHS access and bridleways officer for Herts & Bucks area.

All our virtual talks are free and cover interesting subjects related to horses, equine and competition help.

## Winter Online Dressage Series

These competitions are open to OB club members only and are a perfect opportunity to keep motivated to school and compete during the winter months, without travelling horses away from home or the yard.

With a chance to ride or practice different tests and maybe move up a level.

All the tests are judged by BD dressage judges and the judges will give valuable feedback on the sheets to help riders improve on their test riding and marks.

Tests include: intro, prelim, and novice, PYO: elementary, medium & advanced medium.

Entry fees are  $\pounds 12$  per test and include postage for score sheets and place rosettes.

### Area 6 Qualifiers Reports

#### Introductory championships

The BRC introduced the new grassroots dressage qualifiers with just intro & prelim tests for teams and individuals this year for the more novice riders and their horses & ponies.

The BRC Area 6 qualifier took place in August at Berkshire College.

Two of our members who were placed at the qualifiers were invited to compete at the National introductory championships at Bury Farm on 1<sup>st</sup> October.

Andrea Napier and Simba rode in the intro B championship class and finished in 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Julie Fleming and Artic Clover competed in the Prelim 1 championship test and finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place. Super results for both our members at their very first BRC national championships.





#### Winter intermediate dressage qualifiers

This was on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> October at Wellington Riding near Reading.

We had one senior open team comprising of Elaine Browne & Jay riding prelim 18, Jane Bancroft & Candy in novice 28, Tamsin Morris & Khadira in novice 30 & Diane Hunt & Barry in elementary 42. Everyone rode really good tests with our team finishing in 3rd place against 21 other riding club teams!

There were individual placings for Jane Bancroft with  $1^{st}$  place in N28 and  $6^{th}$  in novice 30. Tamsin was  $5^{th}$  in novice 30.

The PYO class has grown over the years with 8 entries.

Jillie Luff and Corby competed and won the medium 63 test.



# Winter novice dressage qualifiers - report by Jane Bancroft.

Seven members braved sub zero temperatures to compete on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> December at Wellington Riding Centre.

It was brilliant to have 2 teams and 4 individuals representing the club.

Everyone rode very well and produced some impressive tests and results.

The Gold team finished in 12<sup>th</sup> place – riders were: Elaine Browne – prelim 7, Alison Dippenaar – prelim 12 (Jazz), Anna Smallwood – Novice 24, Anka Taylor – novice 27.

The Blue team of 3 riders were Alison Dippenaar (Katie) – prelim 12, Jane Bancroft – novice 24, Elizabeth Etchells – novice 27. The team finished in  $4^{th}$  place.

We also entered members to compete individually & represent the club. Elaine Browne was 8<sup>th</sup> in prelim 12. Elizabeth Etchells was 4<sup>th</sup> in novice 24, Janine Modder finished in 10<sup>th</sup> place in novice 27 and Jane Bancroft came 2<sup>nd</sup> in novice 27.
