Deerhunter Dressage Trophy – Area tests: Intro, prelim, novice.

Winner: Jane Bancroft and Candy had a very successful outing at the summer dressage. Qualified for the riding test and Novice 24 & then competed at the BRC National Championships at Lincoln with a place in both championships classes.
