Tests cover intro, prelim, novice & PYO: elementary or medium and are ridden in 20m x 40m marked arenas.

Members can choose which tests they want enter, then ask someone to video the test.

All tests are judged by a BD judge who gives feedback on the score sheets to help riders improve on their test riding and marks.

Entry fee: £12 per test includes place rosette and score sheet posted.

Entry fee: £10 per test for just score sheet posted.

BRC Area 6 Competition Qualifiers Reports

The BRC have changed the introductory and DTM championships from October to March, which meant extra winter qualifiers for both introductory and DTM.

Area 6 organised the introductory qualifier at Berkshire College of Agriculture on Saturday 6th January.

We had a brilliant outing at this competition on Saturday 6^{th} January with the OBRC members winning the team competition and have qualified for the BRC championships at Bury Farm, Slapton on 10^{th} March.
