#### **Open Summer Dressage Series**

Four Thursday evening competitions Fullers Hill Farm, Amersham, HP6 5RQ Dates are: 1<sup>st</sup> June, 6<sup>th</sup> July, and 3rd August. Classes include intro, two prelims and a novice. The competitions are open to non members with a reduced entry for fees for club members.

Good facilities at Fullers Hill Farm with fenced dressage arena, 40m x 40m warm up arena, both on good surfaces, separated by a hedge is large hard standing parking area.

We do offer a nice relaxing place to compete, with helpers available to call tests if needed and excellent experienced BD judges.



Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May was the first competition for 2023 and we had 26 riders competing over the four classes. This competition was an early outdoor dressage for some of our members and they all rode good tests.

#### Competing in the BRC Area 6 Inter-Club Competitions

Every member is welcome to compete in the Area 6 qualifiers in the any of the disciplines.

The Jumping courses start at 70 cm up to 1.05 cm. Dressage starts at intro and goes through levels to PYO medium / advanced medium.

There is also dressage to music, pairs, novice in fancy dress classes.

There is a new qualifier – introductory which is aimed at the more novice riders in dressage with intro and prelim tests and intro pairs class.

We really like entering teams of 4 riders as well as individuals at the competitions as its more interesting and supportive to the members to be part of a team.

Horse trials were at Snowball Farm on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> April.

Janine Modder and Toby had a good dressage score few faults SJ & clear XC finishing in 9<sup>th</sup> position in the 80 cm. Leah Upton and Fred had a fair dressage score, double clear in SJ & XC finished in 10<sup>th</sup> position in the 80 cm.

Anka Taylor and Ella rode in the 90 cm finishing in  $3^{rd}$  with a good dressage test, double clear SJ & XC.



### Summer Show Jumping Competition on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> May at BCA

This year the format was changed to a single phase rounds on the outside arena.

This proved popular with riders as only one slightly longer round.

We had two teams competing.

80cm team: Leah, Elizabeth, Julia – all jumped well with a team  $6^{th}$  place.

90cm team: Leah, Anna, Elizabeth – Leah and Elizabeth had a few faults as the jump off was quite big. Anna jumped a double clear finishing in  $3^{rd}$ . With the team in  $2^{nd}$  place.



BRC Intermediate Championships 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> April

Our senior open team were invited to compete at the dressage championships at Onley Grounds, Rugby on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> April.

Elaine Browne & Legacy Jay finished 15<sup>th</sup> place in prelim 18. Jane Bancroft and Candy Blue finished in 18<sup>th</sup> place.

Tamsin Morris and Khadira rode an excellent test and won the Novice 30 championship test as an individual.

The team finished in 13<sup>th</sup> position out a staggering 34 teams.

#### BRC Combined Training & Combined Challenge Championships
