How To Sign Up

A \$100 deposit will be accepted immediately to secure bus spots. Space is limited so sign up now. You can pay in full or pay in monthly installments. Please see our website at (<http://mygradtrip.com>), contact your trip coordinator or e-mail us at info@mygradtrip.com.) Methods of Payments are Check, Cash, Zelle, Venmo or PayPal on our website, Mygradtrip/info@mygradtrip.com.

Payments totaling \$315 are required by MARCH 8th or your spot will be forfeited.

Day 1: Wednesday, May 22nd, 2024

- 4:30am-5:45am Check in and loading. We will be at AMC 30 parking lot I-17 and 101.
- 6:00 am sharp Departure
- 8:00 am 15-minute mandated rest for the bus drivers. You will not be allowed to exit the bus.
- 1:00pm Arrive in Anaheim – we will immediately walk to Disney as a group to check in. You will have the ability to use your Park Hopper Pass at Disneyland and California Adventure during normal operating hours until 9:00pm. You will then have access to California Adventure and Grad Nite until 2:00am. While inside you enjoy a private *California Adventure* experience with a dance party. Once checked in as a group, you are free to come and go as you please from the Disney Parks.
- 4:00pm-8:00 pm Check in to your rooms – you must leave the park and come to the hotel where we will get you checked in with your luggage.
- 9:00 pm Arrive at California Adventure for the Grad Nite party.
- 2:00am Depart Disney and head back to the hotel.
- 2:15am Arrive at the hotel for some rest.

Day 2: Thursday, May 23rd, 2024

- 9:30am-10:00am Board bus for departure to Magic Mountain
- 11:30am Arrive at Magic Mountain or for 8 hours of rides and experiences.
- 5:30pm-6:00pm Board Busses for trip back to our Anaheim Hotel. **Buses will leave PROMPTLY at 6:10pm. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 7:30pm Arrive @ Hotel for some rest.

Day 3 Friday, May 24th, 2024

- 9:00 am Check out of your rooms. (After a room inspection we will board our bus for **Huntington Beach**) You will need to make sure that your luggage is on the bus, and you have everything you will need for the day.
- 10:15 am **Huntington Beach** (at the beach prepare for a day of sun, shopping, biking, volleyball plus much more. Don't forget your sunscreen.) Lunch is on your own at the many varied restaurants in Huntington Beach.
- 5:00 pm Depart **Huntington Beach** and Head for Home (There will be a 45-minute food stop on the trip back)

Saturday, May 25th, 2024

- 1:30 am Arrive back at Shopping Center

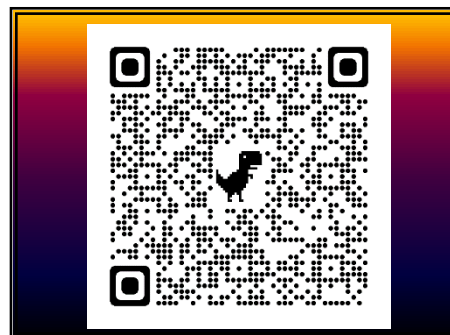

Payment Schedule C:

We will accept students until the final bus has been filled.

**** These payment schedules are used as a guideline** for My Grad Trip. Missing payments based on these schedules **will not result** in forfeiture of reservation as long as the \$315 deposit has been placed by March 8th and a full payment is received by May 1st. If \$315 is not received by March 8th, your spot will be automatically forfeited, and your payments will be refunded minus a 3% processing fee. No exceptions.

NOTE: After March 8th ALL MONEY IS NON-REFUNDABLE. NO EXCEPTIONS

Cancellation: All cancellations must be in writing and signed by the participant before March 8th. All deposits are refundable up until March 8th **minus a 3% processing fee.** After March 8th, the initial \$315 deposit becomes non-refundable but is transferrable. You must find your own replacements and exchange your own monies. No substitutions or transfers will be allowed within 14 days of departure.

Roommates: The price of the trip is based upon 4 students per room. It is the participant's responsibility to pick their roommates, we will do our best to honor these requests but there are no guarantees. The later you sign up the less likely we will be able to honor room requests. For an extra fee we will allow triple, double or single occupancy at the hotel (please contact your coordinator for details).

Disney Requirements: Disney Properties may require a specific dress code for their Grad Nite event. No inappropriate language or attire will be tolerated. No outside food or drink is allowed to be brought into Disneyland or California Adventure. **Disney is a has strict rules on smoking and vaping for this event, all cigarettes and vaping items will be confiscated. Bags will be checked, and items will be discarded.** Perfume and medicine will not be allowed into the park as well. Some prescription items may be exempt from this ban. Prescription rules will be disseminated closer to our travel dates. My Grad Trip LLC assumes no responsibility for any students not meeting the dress code or banned substance rules and will not bare any responsibility for a student being denied entrance into the park.

Parent Permission Form: All Grads are required to submit their signed parent Permission Form, Medical Release Form, and any appropriate Park Release Forms before departure. Forms can be requested by e-mailing us at info@mygradtrip.com or found on our website at <http://mygradtrip.com> **No participant will be permitted to travel without these signed forms. No refund will be given if these forms are not received before departure.**

Chaperoned Event: Chaperones are not responsible for the behavior of participants and/or nonparticipants. The chaperone's role is to provide a responsible presence during the trip. Chaperones are required on all trips and are selected by the organizers.
