MOVE OUT PROCEDURES – Sun, Feb. 25, 2024

Thanks for participating in the Junior Ag Mechanics Show! - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1. <u>6:30 a.m.</u> all Tractor, Trailer and towed projects will be moved out to Lot 5 on the north side of the Morris Center & Swine Barn.
 - EXHIBITORS OF THESE PROJECTS MUST REMOVE ALL MATERIALS FROM THEIR AREAS SATURDAY AFTER JUDGING IS COMPLETE FOR UNOBSTRUCTED MOVE OUT.
 - Tractor Project Exhibitors, please be available to ensure your Tractor is moved out of the barn prior to 8:00 a.m.
- 2. Pre-Release 9:30 a.m. Tractor Projects are encouraged to send their driver to Salado for staging.
- 3. NO PROJECTS WILL LEAVE THE GROUNDS UNTIL THE AWARDS CEREMONY IS OVER. <u>EXHIBITOR CARDS</u> SHOULD REMAIN ON PROJECTS UNTIL LOADED ONTO VEHICLES.
- 4. Immediately after Awards:
 - Marketplace Auction participants and items will remain in Swine Barn for Auction.
 - JAM Show exhibitors proceed immediately to Salado Lot for staging.
 - If you have a transport trailer, hook up first and then proceed to Salado Lot.
 - All Project Release forms will be validated (stamped) at the Salado Lot.
- 5. Vehicles will be staged according to the Project Type Hang Tag given at Check-In (X,F,H,T,O M tags do not apply on Sunday).
 - **YOU WILL NEED YOUR PROJECT TYPE HANG TAG VISIBLE IN YOUR FRONT WINDOW.
 PLEASE FOLLOW COMMITTEE DIRECTIONS**
- 6. Vehicles will be given a laminated "Ticket to East Gate" card and their Project release stamped before being released from Salado to the East Gate.
- 7. After entering East Gate on the Stock Show Grounds, stay in the main load-out lines until directed to the appropriate loading area by a committee member.

Other Important Notes:

- Safety First Our Goal is to get you moved out and loaded as safely and quickly as possible.
- Please follow all directions given to you by the Ag Mechanics Committee
- Please do not leave your vehicle unattended in the staging lines or in the Loading area.
 VEHICLES CAN AND WILL BE TOWED!
- Exhibitors will not be permitted to ride on trailers / projects for any reason!
- Please keep fire lanes open at all times
