Policy Statement:

The Village of Cache Creek desires to provide waste collection services to businesses on an equal basis.

Purpose:

As most Cache Creek businesses have bins provided by the Village of Cache Creek, those who purchased their own bins when requested to do so by the Village when this service was first established may wish to apply to the Village to have their bin purchased by the Village, who would thereafter own the bin and be responsible for maintenance and upkeep.

Procedures:

- 1. At least once annually, those businesses who own their own garbage bins will be offered the sum of \$2500.00 from the Village of Cache Creek to purchase their bin until all business-owned garbage bins have been purchased by the Village of Cache Creek.
- 2. Any business wishing to sell their bin to the Village of Cache Creek must first complete the attached form and submit it to the Village Office.
- 3. Village of Cache Creek records show that the following premises have purchased their own four cubic yard garbage bins:
