Use of Aquatic Centre Diving Boards

Policy Statement:

The use of the diving boards at the Cache Creek Aquatic Facility shall be strictly regulated.

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the safety of all Aquatic Centre patrons.

Procedures:

- 1. The 3-Metre diving board shall only be open during public swimming when a minimum of two qualified staff members are on deck, one of whom will be situated in the vicinity of the 3-Metre diving board. It will be the responsibility of this lifeguard to insure that all patrons utilizing the 3-Metre and 1-Metre diving boards follow the posted rules governing their use, in addition to scanning the pool.
- 2. The 1-Metre and 3-Metre diving boards shall be used during lessons at the discretion of the instructors.
- 3. If public swimming attendance exceeds the comfort zone of the Aquatic personnel on duty, the 3-Metre diving board shall be closed.
- **4.** In all instances where the 3-Metre diving board is closed a NON-REMOVABLE barrier must be placed at the base of the 3-Metre diving board ladder rungs.
