Ruth's Tips for Watering the Birds



Last month when I chatted about feeding our feathered friends, I could have suggested precautions to take

when supplying water to them. The same disease I mentioned previously is a threat in the water we supply them, too. When they share a birdbath, (where they drink as well as skinny-dip) they can transmit Trichomynosis to those with whom they frolic.

Therefore, if we supply an **additive**, they can be *free as a bird*sorry about that! I maintain six "watering holes" into which I have added an anti-algae solution which can be bought at various stores. It is concentrated and requires only a drop and does not harm the birds or pets and lizards. The formula is on the container.

Since I have so many birdbaths and watering holes, I prepare a bunch in plastic bottles (like Clamato) which are capped. I add that "capped" notation to save you the experience I had when I found a mouse stuck and drowned in a bottle opening. (I'm not a mouse lover, but I'm not a killer either!) I know the product can be purchased at Petsmart, but I used to buy it for less at K-Mart and maybe Walmart has it. Since a drop per gallon is all that is used, it lasts for maybe two years and is more easily controlled and diluted than Clorox, for instance. It should be available at any store selling supplies for fountains, aquariums or maybe pools. Good drinkin' and "here's to 'em"!
