October Board Meeting Highlights

The DCC&R Committee received a complaint about several vehicles parking in the visitor areas on a regular basis. Of the vehicles mentioned, all except one were issued Temporary Permits. The one offending car was ticketed. An irrigation line was replaced under a driveway on Joanna but dur-

ing repair, a gas line was punctured. Emergency services responded and no one was hurt and the damage was quickly repaired. The Welcome Committee greeted five new families to the neighborhood. The Social Committee has planned a "Get Acquainted Coffee" to be held on Saturday, November 15th from 9:00 am to 11 am. It will be hosted by the Board and will be held at the Schessler's home at 4901 W Doria. Owners and residents, old and new, will be encouraged to come have coffee, a Krispy Creme donut and meet your neighbors. A Budget for 2004 was reviewed and adopted. Monthly dues will remain at \$40, but the late fee will increase from the current \$5 to \$10. Nearly 30% of the owners are paying their dues after the 15th and the Board feels that this is not fair to the majority who pay on time. Although late fees raise additional money, it is far more important to pay the bills without dipping into interest bearing savings. The Board also approved and allocated funds for an independent audit of the Association's Financial Records. This will be done in early 2004 and the report provided by the CPA will be sent to all owners with their Annual Meeting package in April 2004. The Approved Budget and new mailing labels for the payment of dues will be sent to all owners very soon. Please note that the Property Manager's mailing address has changed.
