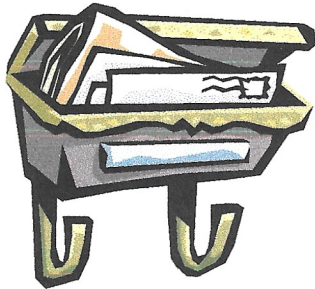

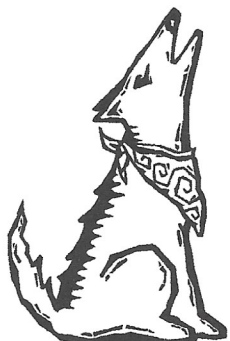

Chinese Fried Rice with Shrimp and Eggs

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ¼ cup salad oil 1 cup raw regular or processed white rice 1 envelope Lipton Noodle Soup Mix with Real Chicken Broth 2½ cups boiling water | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ½ pound fresh shrimp, shelled, cleaned and cut up 2 eggs, slightly beaten ¼ teaspoon salt Few grains pepper 1½ tablespoons soy sauce 2 small scallions, sliced |

- In a large skillet, heat 2 tablespoons salad oil and sauté rice until golden brown.
- Combine soup mix and water and stir into rice. Cover and simmer 30 minutes or until liquid is absorbed.
- In another skillet, heat remaining oil and sauté shrimp quickly about 1 minute. Add eggs, stirring constantly and cook 1-2 minutes. Add salt, pepper and soy sauce.
- Stir shrimp-egg mixture into soup-rice mixture, heat 2-3 minutes. Serve topped with scallions. Makes 4-6 servings.
