Critter Corner: American Lady



A member of the brushfoot family, the American Lady butterfly is found in all types of open habitats, such as meadows, prairies, roadsides, overgrown fields, gardens, and hayfields. It is appropriate that the Latin name is *Vanessa Virginiensis*, since this specimen was photographed in the gardens of Jamestown, VA. Host plants include plantain-leaved pussy-toes, fragrant cudweed, and burdock. Favorite nector plants include Indian hemp, and various milkweeds. The American Lady can be distinguished from its cousin, the Painted Lady, by the presence of two large eyespots on the underside of each wing, instead of four smaller eyes on the Painted Lady.
