| May 29      | [1660] | "Restoration Day," Restoration of Church and Monarchy. (Charles II on his 30 <sup>th</sup> birthday).                               |
| June 4      | [1663] | Archbishop William Juxon died.  |
| June 10     | [1688] | "White Rose Day," Birth of Prince James, son of King James II & VII.  |
| June 18     | [1633] | Coronation of KCI at Holyrood, Scotland.  |
| September 3 | [1658] | <i>Exit Tyrannus.</i> Death of Regicide Oliver Cromwell.  |
| November 19 | [1600] | Nativity of Saint Charles, K.M. Charles Stuart born at Dunfermline Castle to King James VI of Scots and his Queen, Anne of Denmark. |
| December 23 | [1600] | Baptism of Saint Charles, K.M.  |
