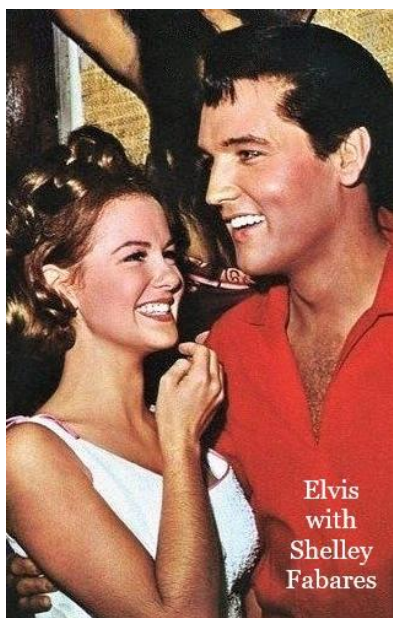


MOVIE MUSIC ELVIS PRESLEY

Elvis Presley was a pioneer of the music industry, similar to what Bing Crosby was in the 1930s and what The Beatles brought to the world in the 1960s. Elvis had all the tools: a distinctive style, good looks, a passion for his craft and an absolutely beautiful voice. And he put them all together like no one else in history.

So where does one start when making a movie music show about Elvis? We decided to place the emphasis on the first half of his 23-year career, which began in 1954. We strived to capture his natural joy of doing what he did better than anyone of his generation, or perhaps any generation: singing from the depths of his soul.

You'll also recognize immediately that we've made every effort to split the screen between Elvis and his leading ladies. Elvis would have liked that, even if his longtime manager Colonel Tom Parker would not. Enjoy the movie music of Elvis Presley.

1. **Spring Fever** from **Girl Happy** (1965) featuring Elvis and Shelley Fabares
2. **GI Blues/Blue Suede Shoes/early Elvis Presley television appearances**
3. **Got a Lot O' Livin'** and **Teddy Bear** from Elvis's second film **Loving You** (1957) co-starring Lizabeth Scott and Dolores Hart
 - Seven leading ladies in Elvis films
4. **Mean Woman Blues** from **Loving You** with appearances by Jana Lund and Kenneth Becker
5. **Jailhouse Rock** (1957) with Elvis dancing to the title song in what has been billed his "best 3 minutes on film"
6. **Love Song for Judy Tyler** by Elvis to the tune **Young and Beautiful** from **Jailhouse Rock** (1957)
7. **I Got Stung** (1958) by Elvis Presley with Judy Tyler that blends the song with images from **Jailhouse Rock** released a year earlier
8. **King Creole** (1958) montage featuring Elvis singing three songs: "Dixieland Rock," "Trouble," and "As Long As I Have You"
9. **The Girl of My Best Friend** (1960) by Elvis featuring his **King Creole** co-star Dolores Hart
10. **Frankfort Special/GI Blues** medley from **GI Blues** (1960) starring Elvis and Juliet Prowse
11. **Can't Help Falling in Love** by Elvis with co-star Joan Blackman from the film **Blue Hawaii** (1961)
12. **African American influences on Elvis** Presley's life from the film **Elvis** (2022) starring Austin Butler, directed by Baz Luhrmann
13. **Bossa Nova Baby & You Can't Say No in Acapulco** from **Fun in Acapulco** (1963) starring Elvis, Ursula Andress and Elsa Cardenas
14. **Elvis and Ann-Margret** warming up starring Ann-Margret in "**Bye Birdie**" (1963) and Elvis in **Kissin' Cousins** (1964)
15. **Viva Las Vegas** (title song) starring Elvis and Ann-Margret (1964)
16. **The Lady Loves Me** from **Viva Las Vegas** (1964) starring Elvis and Ann Margret
17. **Girl Happy** montage (1965) from film of the same name starring Elvis and Shelley Fabares
18. **Puppet on a String** from **Girl Happy** (1965) starring Elvis and Shelley Fabares
19. **Dual Ballads for Shelley Fabares** from **Clambake** (1967) featuring "**A House That Has Everything**" and "**You Don't Know Me**"
20. **A Little Less Conversation** from the film **Live a Little, Love a Little** (1968) with guest appearance in this scene by Celeste Yarnall
21. **Roustabout** medley from the only Elvis Presley film soundtrack that ever ranked in the "top 100 movie soundtracks of all time"
