Here, Numbers on the lines indicate the number of the FRETS and the FINGERS.

- 1 is for INDEX FINGER (First Fret)
- 2 is for MIDDLE FINGER (Second Fret)
- 3 is for RING FINGER (Third Fret)
- 4 is for SMALL FINGER (Fourth Fret)

There are 6 lines which indicates the Strings.

- 1 is the smallest string called the HIGH E String
- 2 is the second string called the B String
- 3 is the third string called the G String
- 4 is the fourth string called the D String
- 5 is the fifth string called the A String
- 6 is the biggest string called the LOW E String

Therefore, the first line on the above example says that

6th String First Finger First Fret.
6th String Second Finger Second Fret.....and so on!
