Purpose of Spiritual Retreat

Any amount of time taken to get away and focus on God will always bear great fruits for an individual or a Church. With a whole world of needs and possibilities facing us, deciding to give our life, energy and time to seek the Lord is a great investment that will yield great reward. Our main objective is to eliminate the distractions around us to allow the Lord to work freely in our lives. In the book of Hosea, God invites us to come to the desert to pray and He will speak to our hearts (Hosea 2:14). This retreat allows us to break the normal routine of our daily lives. When we turn off the television and cell phones and get away from home, we affirm our commitment to spiritual priorities. In stillness, we nourish our lives with the solitude of silence, meditation and prayer.



Physical Preparation

Here are few steps to take that will adequately prepare you for the retreat:

- Make plans for your trip well ahead of time. We highly encourage carpooling with others if possible. Also study the directions carefully, try it on your GPS well before the day of the journey and ask all questions necessary. Failure to do this can bring a lot of stress on the day of the trip and rob you of getting to the retreat with the right frame of mind.
- Make sure you have the phone number of Spruce Lake Retreat with you. If you have problems with direction, it is best to contact the retreat ground for direction. Please note that mobile phone reception is poor in the area except for Verizon wireless & AT&T.
- The retreat program starts with prayer 2pm on Thursday; partial attendance is highly discouraged. The trip takes about 1.5 to 2 hrs. depending on where you live in New Jersey.
- The retreat room check-in time is 4pm-5pm, after which is dinner from 5pm-6:30pm. Please note that there will be no dinner after 6:30pm.
- The retreat meal times are as follows: Thursday: dinner (5-6:30pm) Friday: breakfast (8-9:15am), dinner (6-7pm), Saturday: breakfast (8-9am), lunch (1-2pm).
- Cooking is not allowed in the rooms but you can bring along snacks or canned food if necessary.
- Note that lunch will not be provided on Friday. Please make your lunch arrangement if you desire to have lunch on Friday.
- The retreat accommodation is similar to a hotel or motel; bed, blanket, towel, soap, etc. will be provided.

Spiritual Preparation

Divine visitation always requires spiritual preparation. We believe God will visit us in a mighty way during this retreat. The Pastor and the Church leaders are fasting, praying and believing God for a massive outpouring of the Holy Spirit. However your personal preparation is equally important; you will only experience God according to your faith and the desire of your heart. Prov.23:18, Heb.11:6.

- We encourage everyone to spend some time in fasting and prayer before the retreat using the prayer points on the next page and as you are led. Fasting prepares your heart to be more receptive to God.
- The state of our heart is very important to God. The Lord said we should not come before Him if we have any grudge or un-confessed sin in our life. Hence make sure you reconcile with anyone you have a grudge with before coming to the retreat.
