The August 7th Board of Elections deadline is fast approaching for those interested in running for Council (2 seats) or Mayor in the November election. And there still is an open council seat with a 2½-year term remaining that can be appointed at the August 12 council meeting. Now is the time to decide if you are ready, willing, able...

Volunteers are requested for Village tree-trimming projects; call Bob, 937-548-8427.

The *Hooked on Fishing – Not on Drugs!* event will be over after July 31st. If you are interested in becoming a *Hooked on Fishing* event organizer, call John Winger 937-678-7864. In support of this event, the Village obtained a grant to stock fish, requested ODNR permission for a second stocking by *Hooked on Fishing*, had the portable toilets cleaned two times, and treated Iroquois Lake four times.

Wayne Lakes Beach will continue to be open Friday-Saturday-Sunday weekends until the last day open this year on August 11. Discussion for 2020 plans for the beach will take place during the August 12 council meeting.

A project has been approved by Council to divert water off of low-lying areas as a temporary fix for the Cucumber-to-Ess connection larger project to be considered in the 2020 appropriations.

The water running across Main Drive near the Bait Shop parking area appears to have either stopped on its own or someone found and shut down the source.

Estimates have been received for a possible 2020 re-roof project for the Community Building.

After obtaining further financial understanding for a possible trial for nanobubbles, that lakes treatment is on hold until possibly next year.. To learn more about nanobubbles:
