He was a single father who raised six children. Mark your calendars for Sunday, June 21, 2020 to do something special for our Father's here in the Village. There is so much to enjoy with fishing, go for a walk, take a ride in your golf cart, and then finish up with dinner or lunch from Reed's Gatehouse.

Road repairs are currently being finished in our park. Council approved the Renewal submission for the Levy for general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repairing of streets, roads, and bridges. The Village is currently paying monthly towards new bridges that were built.
