Volunteers will be requesting permission to assist with goose nest disruption. Permits and permission letters will be provided to residents needing this service. Any additional assistance you can give the volunteers is greatly appreciated. Nests will be flagged for future detection.

Brice with Access Engineering and the Wayne Lakes Sewer committee will be completing a work session this month. Final reviews of all responses from the residents, plus researching all undeliverable letters will be completed. The goal is to have everyone in the village connected to all future communications.
