A REVISION OF ORDINANCE #2015-11-01 NOISE ORDINANCE


ORDINANCE REV. NUMBER 2016-10-01

WHEREAS, THE VILLAGE OF WAYNE LAKES HEREBY DETERMINES A NECESSITY TO CLARIFY THE USE OF HOUSEHOLD TOOLS FOR MAINTENANCE OF RESIDENTS PROPERTY. NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF WAYNE LAKES, OHIO. COUNTY OF DARKE BY AT LEAST 2/3 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE PASS FOLLOWING ORDINANCE:

SECTION1: LAWN MOWERS, LEAF AND GRASS BLOWERS, TREE TRIMMERS, WEED TRIMMERS, MULCHING MACHINE, LOG SPLITTERS, WOOD CHIPPPERS, CHAIN SAWS THAT HAVE FACTORY INSTALLED MUFFLER AND EXHAUST SYSTEM ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDINANCE.

SECTION 2: HOURS OF OPERATION ARE TO BE BETWEEN 7:00AM AND 9:00PM FOR USE OF ABOVE EQUIPMENT.

SECTION 3: THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE DECLARED AN EMERGENCY AND SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECTF FROM AND AFTER THE DATE OF PASSAGE.
