5.03 <u>Flat Roofs and Windows.</u> ... Except as otherwise authorized by the Design Committee, the roofs of all structures shall be either wood shingle, slate, tile or Permitted Composition Shingles. "Permitted Composition Shingles" shall be Celetex Presidential, Weathered wood, or other comparable quality shingles as approved by the Design Committee from time to time. Window frames shall be wood or vinyl or other composition materials as approved from time to time by the Design Committee....

Note: Celetex is now CertainTeed.

Currently Eight Composition Shingles are approved by the Design Committee and the HOA board. The Covenants intent is to keep all roofs the same Shape, Look and Weight of at least 350 pd. per sq. in our addition. Color must be Weathered Wood or comparable Sycamore color that matches Weathered Wood.

NOTE: Shingles being installed must be from the same manufacturer as any old ones left (i.e. on ridges, hips, or partial repair jobs).
