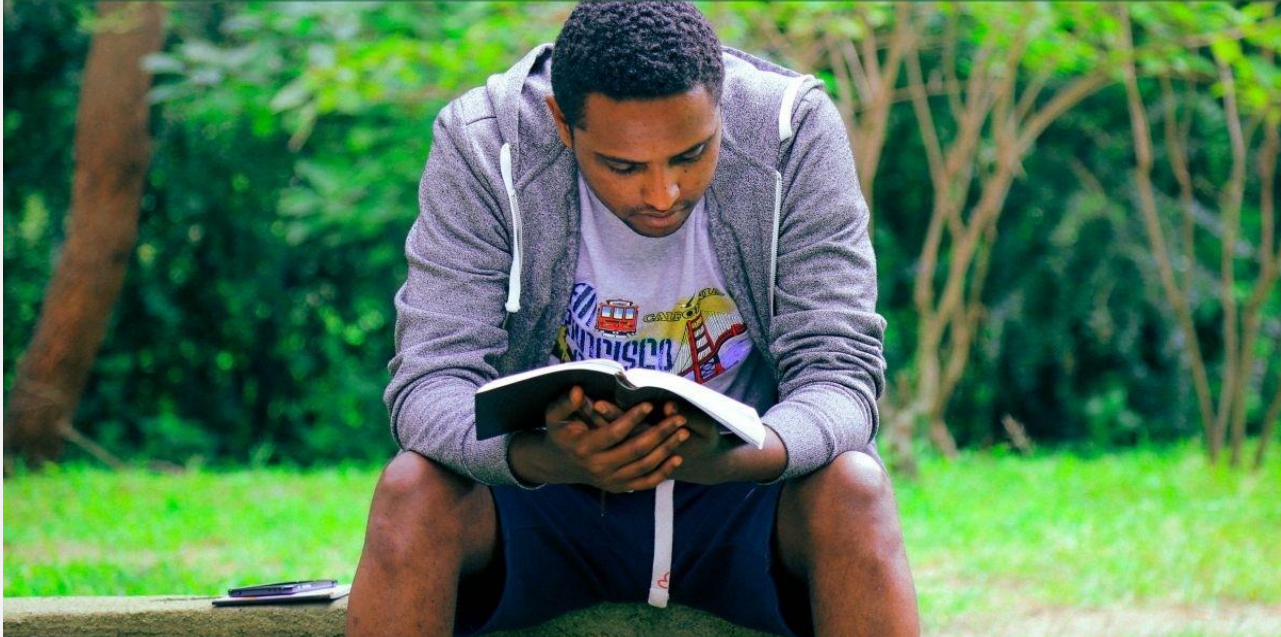

Asking God in harmony with that revelation also yields a rich harvest, namely of answered prayers. In the energising process, the fruit-bearing being a proof of that discipleship.
